Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction for starting the above mentioned courses subject to the approval of Dental

Council of India and affiliation of Universities in addition to the following conditions.

1. Admission to the MDS course will be done on the basis of merit as per the common entrance test conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examination, Government of Kerala.
2. 50% of the seats in each specialization subject will be Government merit seats and allotted by Government on the basis of merit. Balance 50% seats will be management seats and will be allotted on the basis of entrance merit from the candidates qualifying entrance examination.
3. Annual fees for Government merit seats will be Rs.75,000 and that for Management seats will be Rs.5,00,000.
4. If there are odd numbers of seats in any subject, the seats will be rotated between the Management and Government in alternative years. If there is a single seat only in any subject, the first admission go to management quota.
