CLINICAL DIFFERENTIAL DIAGNOSIS OF SWELLING IN LOWER LABIAL MUCOSA.

A 25 year old female patient came to the department of Oral Medicine & Radiology, PMS College of Dental Science & Research with a chief complaint of swelling in lower lip since 1 month.



A provisional diagnosis of mucocele on lower labial mucosa was made which has to be confirmed by a histopathological examination. As a part of differential diagnosis, traumatic fibroma, lipoma, salivary gland tumor can be considered. In this case, there is a keratosed area seen overlying the swelling which is can be caused by the distoincisor angle of 32 which corresponds to the site of lesion. Traumatic fibroma typically grows slowly with a variable consistency of soft to firm, and recurrences are rare. Lipomas, usually occurs as a sessile or pedunculated mass covered by an atrophic epithelium with an underlying adipose tissue often giving lesion a yellowish appearance.

However, mucocles appears as an elevated vesicular lesion which often has a slight bluish or translucent appearance & it is soft & fluctuant. Multiple recurrences and variation in size favours a **mucocele** rather than a traumatic fibroma.
