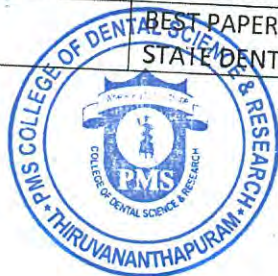

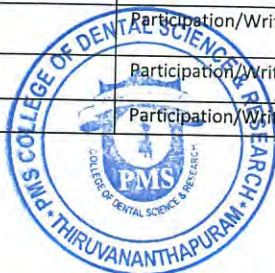

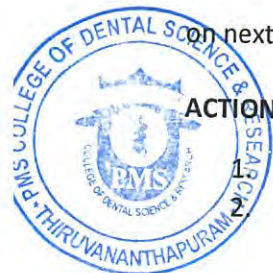

The cultural activity team of PMS aims to encourage student's interest, participation, and responsibility in the ingenious field through a medium of creative art and literary curriculum & Scope.

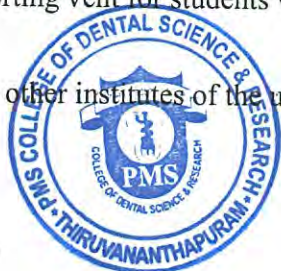
