

EXTENSION AND OUTREACH ACTIVITIES CONSOLIDATED PROGRAM REPORT 2016-2017

Extension and outreach activities during the year 2016-2017 were organized under the supervision of Public Health Dentistry and various other departments. This includes many school camps, treatment camps, oral cancer awareness and screening camps, special camps and various oral health awareness talks on media or public. We sensitize the students to develop social values, widespread their responsibilities and knowledge on issues of the society by making them to involve with the community people.

Oral cancer awareness and screening camps like Snehathalam were conducted by Oral Medicine and Radiology Department of our college in association with Swasthi Foundation and Malayala Manorama. During the year 2016-2017 a total of 9 Snehathalam camps were conducted.

Thoovalsparsham, another oral cancer screening camps were conducted by Department Of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology of our college in association with Department of Health Services of Kerala and Indian Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology at 35 different places in Punalur Thaluk on 8th December 2016. Total 2368 patients were screened during the camps.

Our institution has taken initiative to spread oral health awareness programs through various social medias like television, radio, youtube etc. College faculties and students actively participated in various television programs and radio talk shows to create oral health awareness and discuss related social issues. There were 2 oral health awareness talks on television channels and 1 on radio during 2016-2017

Our institution conducted various camps and various other activities on days of social relevance.

On International Day for Elderly we conducted dental camp in Shanthigiri Ashramam Pothencod, on National Cancer Awareness Day conducted Snehathalam - oral cancer awareness and oral







cancer screening camp in association at Police Headquarters Trivandrum and on World Aids Day participated in HIV Prevention Campaign (UNAIDS Campaign).

There were total of 91 treatment camps and 103 school camps in 2016 and 82 treatment camps and 117 school camps on 2017. Number of people screened in 2016 and 2017 were 64156 and number of treatment done in 2016 and 2017 were 1814. Among this 39 school camps and 40 treatment camps were included in extension outreach activities. The remaining school camps and treatment camps were conducted as part of Final Year Part I students and interns curriculum as stipulated by the institution and Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS).

So during 2016-2017 there were total 95 extension and outreach activities which included 9 Snehathalam camps, I Thoovalsparsham camp (at 35 different places on 6th December 2016), 3 Media awareness program and 3 special camps, 39 school camps and 40 treatment camps.

Extension and outreach activities during the year 2017-2018 were organized under the supervision of Public Health Dentistry and various other departments. This includes many school camps, treatment camps, oral cancer awareness and screening camps, special camps and various oral health awareness talks on media or public. We sensitize the students to develop social values, widespread their responsibilities and knowledge on issues of the society by making them to involve with the community people.

Oral cancer awareness and screening camps like Snehathalam were conducted by Oral Medicine and Radiology Department of our college in association with Swasthi Foundation and Malayala Manorama. During the year 2017-2018 a total of 13 Snehathalam camps were conducted.

There were total of 82 treatment camps and 117 school camps on 2017 and 73 treatment camps and 96 school camps on 2018. Number of people screened in 2017 and 2018 were 61504 and number of treatment done in 2017 and 2018 were 1293. Among this 77 school camps and 74 treatment camps were included in extension outreach activities. The remaining school camps and treatment camps were conducted as part of Final Year Part I students and Interns curriculum as stipulated by the institution and Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS).

Our institution has taken initiative to spread oral health awareness programs through various social medias like television, radio, youtube etc. College faculties and students actively participated in various television programs and radio talk shows to create oral health awareness and discuss related social issues. There were 2 oral health awareness talks on television channels during 2017-2018







A Blood Donation Campaign was conducted in our college in association with Government Medical College, Paripally, Kollam. Dental camps for marginalized sections of society such as t orphanages were conducted during 2017-2018

Our institution conducted various camps and various other activites on days of social relevance. Department of Prosthodontics conducted awareness and demonstration on rehabilitation with maxillofacial prosthesis on World Cancer Day. On Dentist Day – oral health awareness program and dental camp at Govt UPS, Venjaramood and various other competitions were conducted, on Women's Day conducted talk by Cap Dr Rohini Nair and various other competitions like debate, food fest and pick and speak and also conducted dental camp at Govt College, Nedumangad, on World No Tobacco Day, oral cancer screening camp and various other programs were conducted at Institution of Engineers Hall in association with Metro Manorama and Bharath Scouts.

So during 2017-2018 there were total 171 extension and outreach activities which included 13 Snehathalam camps, 2 Media awareness program and 5 special camps, 77 school camps and 74 treatment camps.

Extension and outreach activities during the year 2018-2019 were organized under the supervision of Public Health Dentistry, National Service Scheme and various other departments. This includes many school camps, treatment camps, oral cancer awareness and screening camps, special camps and various oral health awareness talks on media or public. We sensitize the students to develop social values, widespread their responsibilities and knowledge on issues of the society by making them to involve with the community people.

There were total of 73 treatment camps and 96 school camps on 2018 and 78 treatment camps and 110 school camps on 2019. Number of people screened in 2018 and 2019 were 60710 and number of treatment done in 2018 and 2019 were 1185. Among this 74 school camps and 67 treatment camps were included in extension outreach activities. The remaining school camps and treatment camps were conducted as part of Final Year Part I students and Interns curriculum as stipulated by the institution and Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS).

A Blood Donation Camp - ELIXIR was conducted in our college in association with Regional Cancer Centre, Trivandrum. A total of 23 students and 2 faculties participated in blood donation. Dental camps for marginalized sections of society such as tribals, old age homes, orphanages were conducted during 2018-2019

Our institution conducted various camps and various other activites on days of social relevance. On Teacher's Day we conducted felicitation function followed by cultural activities and a rural camp at GHS, Nagaroor. Pink Ribbon, a breast cancer awareness and screening in association with Regional Cancer Center was conducted as part of breast cancer awareness week. On National Dentist Day an awareness talk and dental camp was conducted and various programs were organized like street play , dental quiz, smile competition at Gandhi Park. On International









Women's Day an awareness talk y By Dr Lakshmi Sukumar and a Dental Camp at Govt UPS, Karyavattom was conducted. On World Oral Health Day a treatment camp was conducted on Tribal Settlement area Arippa. Southern Railway and Metro Manorama in association with our college organized flash mob and street play by students on World No Tobacco Day. On World Hepatitis Day an awareness on hepatitis and dental camp was conducted at Pappanamkode School.

Oral cancer awareness and screening camps like Snehathalam were conducted by Oral Medicine and Radiology Department of our college in association with Swasthi Foundation and Malayala Manorama. During the year 2018-2019 a total of 3 Snehathalam camps were conducted.

Our institution has taken initiative to spread oral health awareness programs through various social medias like television, radio, youtube etc. College faculties and students actively participated in various television programs and radio talk shows to create oral health awareness and discuss related social issues. There were 8 oral health awareness talks on media or public during 2018-2019

So during 2018-2019 there were total 160 extension and outreach activities which included 3 Snehathalam camps, 8 Media or public awareness program and 8 special camps, 74 school camps and 67 treatment camps.

CONSOLIDATED PROGRAM REPORT 2019-2020

Extension and outreach activities during the year 2019-2020 were organized under the supervision of Public Health Dentistry, National Service Scheme and various other departments. This includes many school camps, treatment camps, oral cancer awareness and screening camps, special camps and various oral health awareness talks on media or public. We sensitize the students to develop social values, widespread their responsibilities and knowledge on issues of the society by making them to involve with the community people.

There were total of 78 treatment camps and 110 school camps on 2019 and 6 treatment camps and 6 school camps on 2020. Number of people screened in 2019 and 2020 were 34408 and number of treatment done in 2019 and 2020 were 826. Among this 65 school camps and 36 treatment camps were included in extension outreach activities. The remaining school camps and treatment camps were conducted as part of Final Year Part I students and Interns curriculum as stipulated by the institution and Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS).

Dental camps for marginalized sections of society such as tribals, visually impaired, transgenders and migrant workers were conducted during 2019-2020

Our institution conducted various camps and various other activites on days of social relevance. On Nation Tooth Brushing Day a Tooth Brushing and Hand Washing Program and a dental camp was conducted at Kazhanad UPS Kallayam. On International Day of Persons With Disability we conducted dental camp at Government Blind School Vazhuthacaud for Visually Impaired. On National Dentist Day we organized an awareness talk, exhibition and a smile competition.

Oral cancer awareness and screening camps like Snehathalam were conducted by Oral Medicine and Radiology Department of our college in association with Swasthi Foundation and Malayala Manorama. During the year 2019-2020 there was 1 Snehathalam camp.





Our institution has taken initiative to spread oral health awareness programs through various social medias like television, radio, youtube etc. College faculties and students actively participated in various television programs and radio talk shows to create oral health awareness and discuss related social issues. There were 5 oral health awareness talks on media or public during 2019-2020

So during 2019--2020 there were total 110 extension and outreach activities which included 1 Snehathalam camps, 5 Media or public awareness program and 3 special camps, 65 school camps and 36 treatment camps.

Blood Donation camp was conducted in association with National Service Scheme and Alumini of PMS College Of Dental Science and Research at PMS College of Dental Science and Research. Total 28 students and 2 faculties donated blood in this blood donation camp.

Our institution has taken initiative to spread oral health awareness programs through various social medias like television, radio, youtube etc. College faculties and students actively participated in various television programs and radio talk shows to create oral health awareness and discuss related social issues. There were 2 oral health awareness talks on media

So during 2021 there were total 9 extension and outreach activities which included 2 Media or public awareness program and 1 school camp and 5 treatment camps, 1 Blood donation camp. Total number of people screened were 122 and treatment done were 20.
