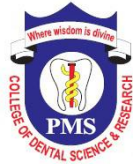

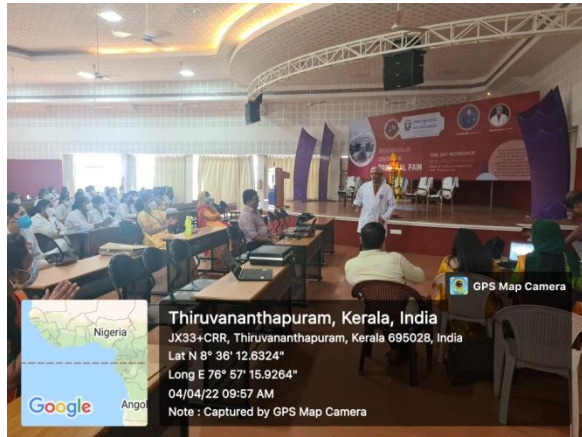
**REPORT**
