

#### INFLAMMATORY FIBROUS HYPERPLASIA: A CASE REPORT

A 54 year old female patient, reported to the Department of Oral Medicine & Radiology, PMS College of Dental Science & Research with Chief complaint of a growth in the maxillary residual ridge with a duration of one year. The swelling was slowly growing and associated with pain only during brushing.

On intra oral examination the maxillary arch is completely edentulous and wearing complete denture for past one year. While wearing the denture it impinges the growth.



The biopsy report confirmed the diagnosis as inflammatory fibrous hyperplasia


