COLLEGE PROFILE

PMS College of Dental Science & Research, set up at Thiruvananthapuram is the brainchild of NRI services and educational trust established in the year 2002. It is a premier Dental College in Kerala, named after the great visionary, Late Sri. P. M. SHAHUL HAMEED, father of our Chairman Dr P S. Thaha.

College is a venture with the cause of enhancing the state's self-reliance in the field of quality education in Dental Medicine and Surgery and is also the first self-financing Dental college in Kerala. The total area of the college is around 2 lakh sq. Feet situated on 12 acres of land at Vattappara, well connected by road, rail and air. The institution, recognized by the Dental Council of India (DCI) is affiliated with the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS). We take pride in saying that the institution was the first to achieve the ISO 9001-2000 certification award among the Dental institution in India and the first Dental College in Kerala with NAAC accreditation.

PMS College of Dental Science & Research started with 40 admissions for BDS Courses and the number of BDS intake increased to 100 in the year 2011. We also started Post Graduation in the year 2010 with 23 admissions and the total seats increased to 36 in 2016.

The College also provides Implantology, Laser Dentistry workshops to give our students the best exposure to the latest trends and innovations in Dentistry. The students and faculty get ample opportunities to associate themselves with several dental programs organized in the college under the guidance of experts from India and abroad.

Welfare Measures for Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff

- Following are the main welfare measures provided to the staff of PMS Dental College by the Management.
- Accident Insurance Coverage: - The College is providing Accident Insurance Scheme to all teaching and non-teaching staff with the tie up of M/s National Insurance Co.Ltd / Bajaj Allianz General Insurance Co. Ltd.
- Employee State Insurance Scheme (ESI): - This is provided to all non-teaching staff towards the medical benefits to staff and their family members. This scheme is under the Employment State Insurance Corporation, Ministry of Law & Employment Govt. of India.
- Staff Hepatitis Screening Camp: - Provides free Hepatitis screening camp every year along with Titer checking and vaccination facility / coverage.
- Provident Fund Scheme: - This scheme is an Investment scheme under Employee Provident Fund Organization under Government of India. Under this scheme, employees are benefited with lifelong pension, Insurance benefit and interest on high returns.
- Staff Quarters: - We are providing staff quarters both family and single accommodation for all teaching and non-teaching who are staying far from the College.
- Financial Assistance during School opening: - All non-teaching staff are given financial assistance during school opening.
- Supply of Uniform: - All maintenance staff, drivers, mess staff and housekeeping staff are given uniform 2 sets per year.



- Supply of Books to School Going Children of staff: - All non-teaching staff who got school going children are provided with 20 note books , Bags and pencil box during school opening every year.
- Festival Allowance: - All non-teaching staff are provided with festival allowance, bonus etc during Onam and Ramzan. Cakes for all teaching and non teaching staff are distributed during every New Year.
- Family get-together: - Family get together are conducted to teaching and non-teaching staff outside the campus.
- Financial Assistance during marriage: - Financial assistance during marriage of the staff and their son/daughter are provided.
- Cash during medical emergencies: - Financial help during medical emergencies are provided for non-teaching staff.
- Day care facility to staff kids: - Staff who got infants below the age of 3 yrs can avail Day care facility for their kids. These facilities are provided w.e.f 2020 .
- Loans for Emergency : Financial help in case of emergencies are being provided to teaching staff by means of Loans & advances without Interest .
- .Sports and Games facility to staff such as swimming pool, basketball court, gyms etc are provided for their entertainment and exercise.

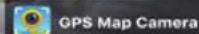

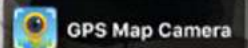

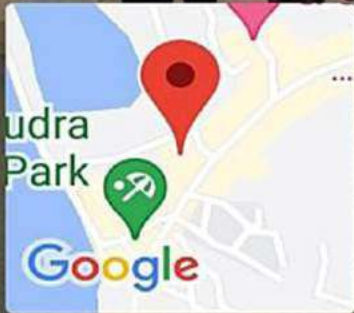
