COLLEGE PROFILE

PMS College of Dental Science & Research, set up at Thiruvananthapuram is the brainchild of NRI services and educational trust established in the year 2002. It is a premier Dental College in Kerala, named after the great visionary, Late Sri. P. M. SHAHUL HAMEED, father of our Chairman Dr P S. Thaha.

College is a venture with the cause of enhancing the state's self-reliance in the field of quality education in Dental Medicine and Surgery and is also the first self-financing Dental college in Kerala. The total area of the college is around 2 lakh sq. Feet situated on 12 acres of land at Vattappara, well connected by road, rail and air. The institution, recognized by the Dental Council of India (DCI) is affiliated with the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS). We take pride in saying that the institution was the first to achieve the ISO 9001-2000 certification award among the Dental institution in India and the first Dental College in Kerala with NAAC accreditation.

PMS College of Dental Science & Research started with 40 admissions for BDS Courses and the number of BDS intake increased to 100 in the year 2011. We also started Post Graduation in the year 2010 with 23 admissions and the total seats increased to 36 in 2016.

The College also provides Implantology, Laser Dentistry workshops to give our students the best exposure to the latest trends and innovations in Dentistry. SOCIAL COMMITMENTS

Being a vision oriented institution, the social commitments, providing an inclusive environment and serving the society is an inevitable part for the institution. All the institutional celebrations focus on creating an inclusive environment encompassing different religions, communities, regional and national culture. The project ‘Susmeram’ initiated by the institution aims at adopting Vembayam Grama Panchayat providing 100% oral awareness and tobacco cessation among its population which is a continuous project for sensitizing the society. Our NSS unit and other committees are actively engaging in charity activities and socially relevant works.

WELFARE MEASURES FOR TEACHING AND NON-TEACHING STAFF

Our Teaching and Non-teaching staff is the lifeline of the institution and the management is highly supportive towards the teaching and non-teaching staff. Welfare measures include Accidental Insurance coverage, Employee State Insurance scheme, Provident Fund Scheme and free hepatitis screening camp every year along with tire checking and vaccination facility. Incentives are given as a token of appreciation to teaching staff for publishing indexed international and national journals. Financial help in case of emergencies is being provided to teaching staff by means of loans and advances without interest. Leave with pay are provided to teaching staff for attending seminars, workshops, conferences and educational purposes. Medical Accident prevention society membership are provided free of cost to all teaching staff. Staff quarters, single accommodation and day care facility is also provided. Non-teaching staffs are provided with accoutrements during school opening every year and with festival allowance or bonus during festive seasons. Family leave are provided to teaching staff as a voluntary measure for the betterment of their family. Leave with pay are given for teaching staff for medical reasons for themselves and their family members. Faculties are encouraged to pursue higher studies such as PhD and other fellowship courses and provides adequate support in terms of paid leaves and special leaves and lighter workload.

WELFARE MEASURES FOR TEACHING AND NON-TEACHING STAFF

Following are the main welfare measures provided to the staff of PMS Dental College by the Management.

1. **Accident Insurance Coverage:** - The College is providing Accident Insurance Scheme to all teaching and non-teaching staff with the tie up of M/s United India Insurance Co. Ltd .
2. **Employee State Insurance Scheme (ESI):** - This is provided to all non-teaching staff towards the medical benefits to staff and their family members. This scheme is under the Employment State Insurance Corporation, Ministry of Law & Employment Govt. of India. Under this Scheme, maternity leave with medical facilities are provided to all non-teaching staff.
3. **Staff Hepatitis Screening Camp:** - Provides free Hepatitis screening camp every year along with Titer checking and vaccination facility / coverage.
4. **Provident & Pension Fund Scheme:** - This scheme is an Investment scheme under Employee Provident Fund Organization under Government of India. Under this scheme, employees are benefited with lifelong pension, Insurance benefit and interest on high returns. Non-teaching staff is registered under this scheme.
5. **Staff Quarters:** - We are providing staff quarters both family and single accommodation for all teaching and non-teaching who are staying far from the College.

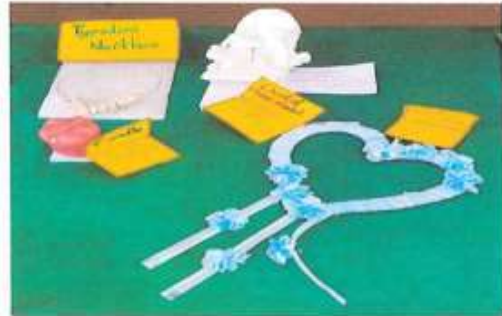

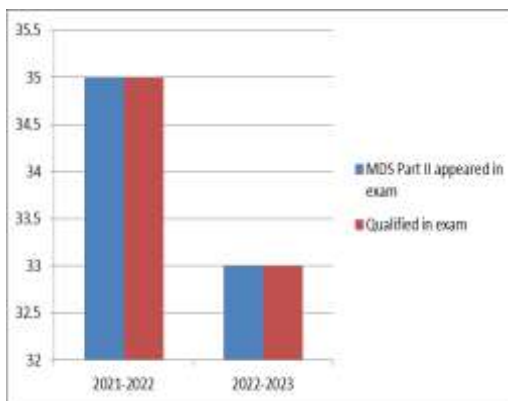
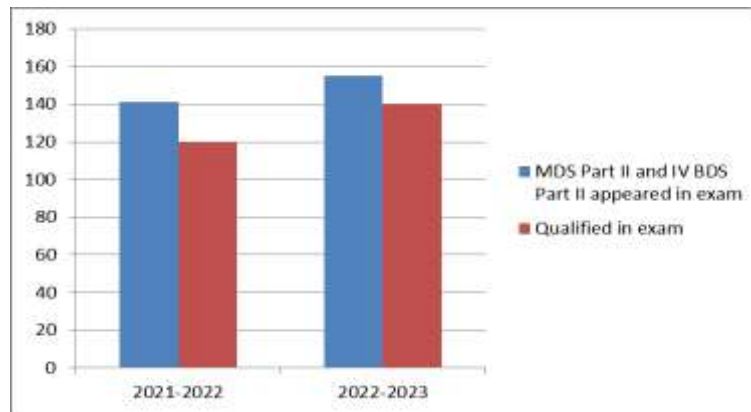

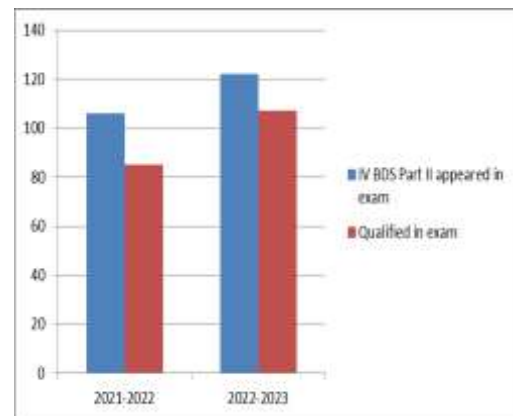

Trend Analysis of Qualified Final Year Students with Comparison of Academic Year 2022-2023 with 2021-2022



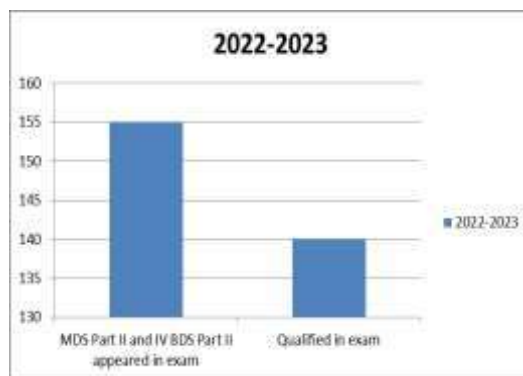
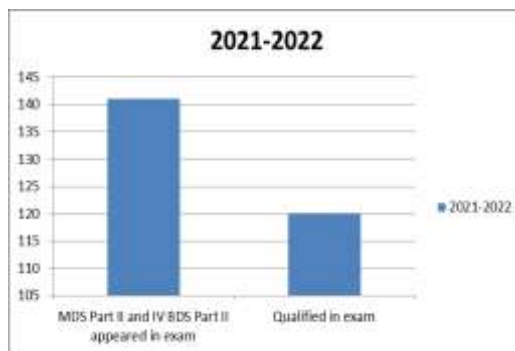
Trend Analysis of Qualified MDS Part II Students with Comparison of Academic Year 2022-2023 with 2021-2022
