## REPORT ON THE CDE ON SKELETAL ANCHORAGE IN ORTHODONTICS ON 29<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2024

The workshop commenced at 09:00 AM with Registration, marking the beginning of a comprehensive day focused on advanced orthodontic techniques and case management.

At 09:30 AM, the first lecture titled "Clinical Applications and Management of Complex Cases with Infra Zygomatic Crest Implants and Buccal Shelf Screws" was delivered by Dr. Vivek Patni. This session extended until 11:15 AM, providing valuable insights into the usage and outcomes of skeletal anchorage techniques in complex clinical scenarios. A tea break was observed at 11:15 AM, offering participants a short recess before resuming the academic sessions.

The second lecture began at 01:30 PM, presented once again by Dr. Vivek Patni, covering "Mini Implant Assisted Rapid Palatal Expansion – Clinical Considerations and Management". This session explored the indications, techniques, and outcomes associated with MARPE in contemporary orthodontic practice. The lecture concluded at 01:00 PM, followed by a lunch break until 01:45 PM.

The concluding session of the day, from 01:45 PM to 03:00 PM, was conducted by Dr. Roopesh R. This segment featured a retrospective analysis of treated cases, accompanied by an interactive session and clinical demonstration. Participants engaged in discussion and observed practical demonstrations, enhancing the applicability of learned concepts.
